- Design and development of intelligent systems or applications using emerging technologies in the field of Computer engineering.
- Development of software tools, mobile/web applications, or platforms for education, community service, or accessibility. These should be deployable, professional-grade solutions built with modern software engineering practices and the latest technologies.

Note:-

- 1. The above-mentioned points are only to aid student's imagination, nevertheless students are encouraged to submit any proposal related to the field of computer engineering.
- 2. The proposals must be submitted by groups of students (2 to 4 students in each group) rather than individually.
- 3. Students may consult any faculty member of the department for opinion and help.
- 4. The proposal should mention team members, proposed title, brief introduction to the project, methodology, underlying technology, etc. and should comprise of three to five pages only.
- 5. Students may specify the name of three faculty members as their proposed project guides in order of preference. However, the final allocation of project guides shall be finalized by the department.
- 6. The first presentation of the project proposals shall be conducted on 23-09-2025. Each group will be required to prepare and present a PowerPoint presentation comprising of 8 to 10 slides.
